

## AVELINE'S HOLE Burrington Combe, Somerset, England

This famous archaeological site close-by the Rock of Ages in Burrington Combe has only one postcard recorded of its entrance. The early photograph of its entrance can also be found on the Westfield Letter Card (ref. Appendix 8). Numerous cards may be found showing its location but the entrance itself is usually masked by a small bush or the angle of the photograph is such that the cave entrance is barely visible (see illustration)
