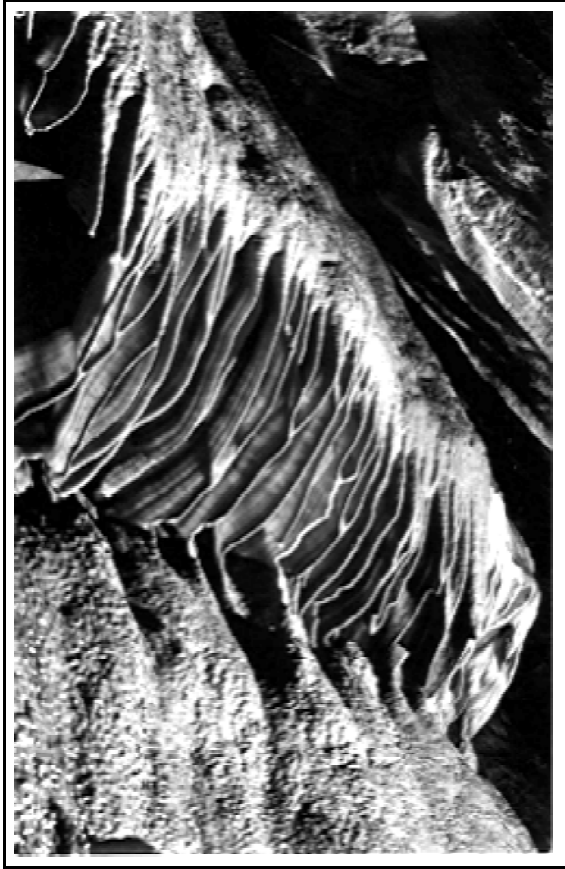


Brief note

The cave was discovered in 1960 by quarrying operations. Shortly after the entrance was buried under quarry rubble. It is probable that the fine formations within this 100m long cave are now shattered by subsequent blasting.
