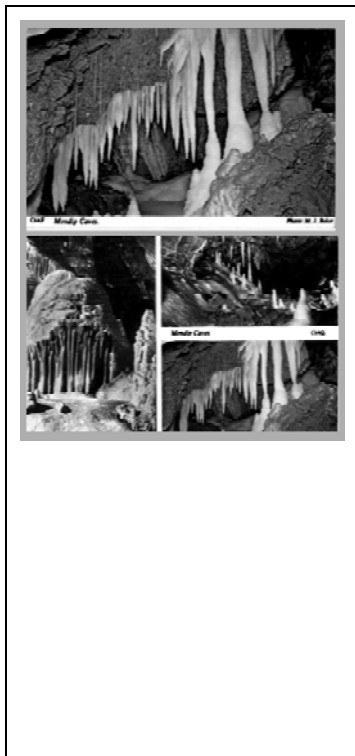


# ST. CUTHBERT'S SWALLET, Priddy, Somerset, England

## Brief note

The cave was discovered in 1953 by the Bristol Exploration Club after several excavations at the site and is now the second longest of the Mendip caves at 7,000m. It is extremely complicated but contains some of the finest formations in the country.

A multi-view card published by English Life Publications, Derby, includes a view of the climb to Gour Hall in St. Cuthbert's Swallet. The card is listed under that publisher in the Wookey Hole Cave catalogue.

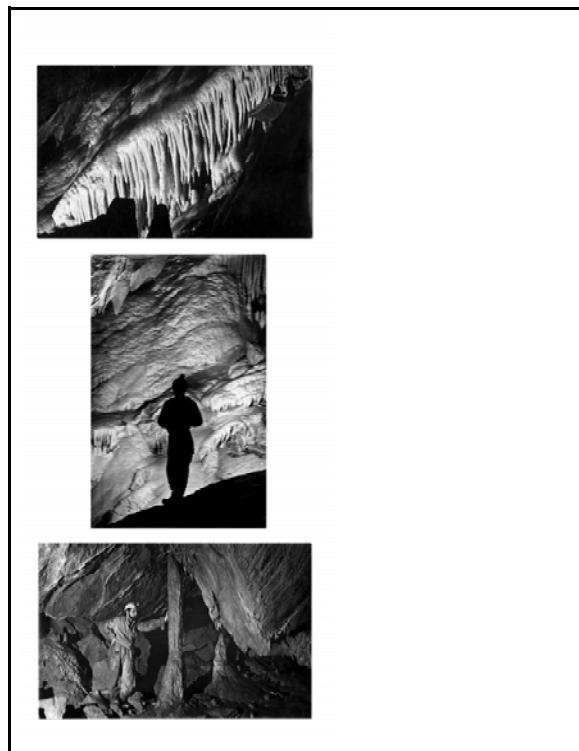
C6AF Mendip Caves. [(H); f1; p1; columns in the balcony formations, September Series]
